Dear Member,

Re: Constitution for season 2006/07.

The consultation period for the proposed Constitution has now finished. The final draft constitution has been completed and is put forward by the League for approval at an EGM to be held on Thursday 20th July 2006.

The proposed constitution and structure are attached.

After consultation with some clubs we have agreed the following changes.

1. Heathrow Seniors moved from 4 West to 7 South
2. British Council from 5 South to 6 South.
3. Clapham IV has been moved to 5 South, and Temple Bar to 6 South. These changes are made to balance the first two changes.

Shene Old Grammarians have asked that their reserves be placed in 3 West. The only way to agree to this request would be to have 12 teams in 3 West or remove one of the other 11 teams. We have rejected the request.

I do remind all clubs that the League tends to lose teams during the close season so the Constitution is subject to adjustment.

We **must** come to an agreement on the 20th.

Since the AGM I have received numerous emails about regionalisation, the number of regions and indeed where the borders between regions should be. There are a lot of different views, and probably too many to discuss adequately at the EGM. From August I would like to seek the views of all the Clubs and League Officers about the future structure and regionalisation of the League. I would like us to agree, by December, a structure to be in place for 2007/08. I hope that clubs and officers can be patient for one year while we sort through all the different opinions.
